Code of Conduct: Each event has a specific purpose (e.g. field trips to educate, showcase events, conferences, meetings and fellowship), therefore for any event that NHEA sponsored families may attend, those families members must agree to act according to the spirit of each event. To accomplish that each member must agree to the following:

Respect for authority will be the hallmark of our group. In that sense, we will respect adults, parents, rules and property. No physical or verbal abuse will be allowed between children, and coarse, loud or suggestive language will not be tolerated.

No child will be dropped off at any event unless another parent has specifically agreed to be a "designated guardian" of that child during the event whose name must appear on the event registration. In such an instance an "emergency information sheet" will be in that person's possession.

Parents are expected to model and enforce attentive behaviour to field trip hosts. Parents will bring children that are neat, clean, safe, and decent. A proper appearance is essential to our testimony.

Young men and women are not to display physical affection, such as holding hands or separating themselves from the group, at any event. Our group stands as a testimony to Jesus our Saviour. We want to act and conduct ourselves in a way that reflects that to each other and to non-members.

NHEA will not be held legally responsible for any accidents or injuries that may occur at any event. Those who are members of HSLDA are personally insured for any home school events which they participate in or organize. Non-HSLDA members are not insured even if they attend an event that an insured person organizes.

NHEA believes in the supreme and final authority of the Word of God as recorded in the Old and New Testaments.

NHEA recognizes that there may be areas where members committed to the inspiration of Scripture will differ.

NHEA does not align itself with any denomination or particular views, and members may have opposing views. We expect that members and adherents behave in a manner showing utmost respect and regard for one another, promoting a spirit of tolerance in those areas that members may differ.

The following is an excerpt from our Constitution:

1. Niagara Home Educators (NHEA) is a Christian organization. It bases all its policies and actions on Christian principles, taking the Holy Bible as its moral and spiritual guide.

2. NHEA functions as a network in the Niagara Region that links home schooling families together, as well as being a source of information to the general public. NHEA endeavours to provide information, encouragement, ideas and resources to all its members and adherents through various means.

3. For the purpose of this constitution, the definition of the family will be as follows:

The scriptural and traditional model begins with one man and one woman within the confines of a marriage relationship. The children expand the family. We recognize extended families or a single parent who may be raising children on their own. God gives parents the ultimate responsibility to love, nurture, train, educate and discipline their children according to His will and way as set forth in the Holy Bible. Therefore, acceptance of application for membership or adherence will be based only on the above definition of the family.

You may choose to be involved with NHEA through adherence rather than through membership. An adherent is someone who either cannot join because of philosophical differences as printed in our definition, or wishes not to become a member for other reasons. Adherents do not have voting privileges at meetings. Adherents are expected to show deference to the philosophy, standards and beliefs of Niagara Home Educators.
